Lake Camanche's current elevation is **210.65 feet** above sea level. The **inflow** from Lake Pardee is currently at 158 c.f.s. The spill is at 0 c.f.s.

The **outflow** from Lake Camanche is currently **225 c.f.s.** The lake is **60% full** & the water temperature is **52° F** degrees.

Bank Report has been Night Crawlers, Sherbet Power Bait, and Char-treuse Power Bait.

Bass Report

Reports have been Spinners this week only. Trolling depth is 25-30' no more than 20' away from piles, and cliffs faces. Anglers have reported using drop shots, and rubber worms.

The Crappie bite is no longer myth! The reports are starting to pick up using jigs and oddly Power Bait.
