Lake Camanche's current elevation is **208.37 feet** above sea level. The **inflow** from Lake Pardee is currently at 232 c.f.s. The spill is at 0 c.f.s.

The **outflow** from Lake Camanche is currently **330 c.f.s.** The lake is **57% full** & the water temperature is **59° F** degrees.

Trolling Report has been between 40; below surface. Primary report has been all colors of Speedy Shiners. Temperatures are rising, so the trout are going deeper.

Bank Report has been Trout Magnets, Spoons, Power Bait (Garlic) and Mice Tails.

Bass Report

Reports have been Spinners this week only. Trolling depth is 30-40' no more than 20' away from piles, and cliffs faces. Anglers have reported using Senkos and Roboworms.

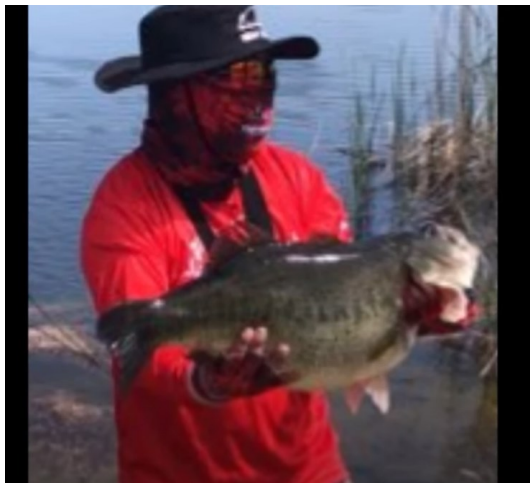
